MAGAZINE SUBSCRIPTION FUNDRAISING COORDINATOR/ COMMITTEE

Involves sending out magazine catalogues and order forms to students in classes, liase with magazine subscription company, organize incentive draws, and collect subscription orders. (**2 weeks in November—1 hour per day whichever days you are available within the two weeks**)

MOVIE NIGHTS COORDINATOR/ COMMITTEE

Involves picking and booking movie, booking gym, advertising, collect money and issue tickets, coordinate and sell food before and during evening. (**Event is approx 3 to 4 times per year**)

SUB DAYS

Volunteers to pack lunches. (**Last Monday of each month from 11:30 to 1 pm**)

WREATHS

Collating forms up to **2 hours at home**, helping on delivery day (**early December—3 to 6 pm**)

YEARBOOK COMMITTEE

Help with advertising sales, photo contributors of pictures taken within the school and from field trips. (**Throughout the year**)

FOOD DRIVE

Coordinate or help with Christmas food drive for the Fair Share Food Bank. (**Flexible**)

CHAPTER'S SHOPPING NIGHT

Great opportunity for someone who works during the day and has evenings free. Coordinate evening's activities at Chapters on an evening in November. Help out on evening greeting and at food table (**one hour shifts**)

CHRISTMAS SHOPPING FOR STUDENTS

This event provides a low priced shopping venue for kids to purchase items for their family members at Christmas. **Help is needed to coordinate and work on the 2 days of shopping in shifts (cashiers and wrappers).**

COINS FOR CHRISTMAS

Classroom coordinators to help with individual class coin drives to purchase gift cards for families in need in the community to enable them to purchase their own gifts for their family members. **Set your own hours during month of December.**

MITTEN TREE

Coordinate or help with Christmas mitten and hat donations for distribution by the Salvation Army. Put up tree on Dec 1, prepare notice to bring in items and distribute to classes, take items to Salvation Army.

CAMPBELL SOUP LABELS

Sort count and bundle soup labels, which in turn are redeemed for merchandise for the school. **Once per month** gather labels from the office, count, tie, return to the office.

DANCE-A-THON

Assist with returned pledge forms and other event duties as required. Soliciting prizes from businesses. **Event duty is in April. One to two hours whichever days you are available in a two week period.**

STAFF APPRECIATION DAY

Coordinate or help put together a staff luncheon in **June**. Help also on the day of the event.

GRADE 8 GRAD COMMITTEE

Parents of Grade 6 & 7 students are needed to coordinate, purchase food, decorate, hand out programs, etc. Great way to find out what is ahead for your child when they graduate!

ABSENCE CHECK

Confirm absentee students from the classroom attendance books and contact the parents/caregivers to confirm the absence. Office staff assist. **This is done twice daily 9 to 10:30 am and/or 1:50 to 2:30 pm.**

ALL STAR READING PROGRAM

Assist students with reading skills. Training is provided by staff. **(Throughout the year)**

LIBRARY HELPERS

To assist with checking-in books, assist students with book selection, processing new purchases and shelving books.
